GIFT	ACTIONS	DEFINITION
ADMINISTRATION	Managing, organizing	Ability to manage and organize people, information, and things to work efficiently in the body of Christ.
APOSTLE	Initiating	Ability to see the overall picture of how the purposes of God can be furthered and to provide what is needed or lacking.
DISCERNMENT	Evaluating, sensitivity	Ability to perceive whether a person ministering in God's name really has their source from God, Satan, or human power.
EVANGELISM/ EVANGELIST	Recruiting	Ability and drive to communicate with boldness and confidence the good news of Jesus Christ to those who are not believers.
EXHORTATION	Counseling, motivation	Ability to comfort, encourage, confront, challenge, and instruct others by motivating and guiding toward truth.
FAITH	Initiating, believing	Ability to believe God with extraordinary confidence for changes and spiritual growth, knowing that God will fulfill His purposes.
GIVING	Resourcing needs	Ability to determine the needs of people and provide financial or other resources to help meet those needs.
HEALING	Physical healing	Ability to call upon God to heal the sick supernaturally, demonstrating the power and glory of God.
HELPS	Detailed implementing	Ability to work alongside another and help that person complete the tasks and use the spiritual gifts God gave them.
KNOWLEDGE	Understanding	Ability to seek out, remember, and make effective use of a variety of information on a number of diverse subjects.

GIFT	ACTIONS	DEFINITION
LEADERSHIP	Managing, organizing	Ability to provide overall vision and direction to do God's work while coordinating efforts so that others willingly follow and work together.
MERCY	Relieving emotional hurt	Ability to perceive the hurts of others who suffer with great empathy and compassion and consoling them without condemnation.
MIRACLES	Authenticating	Ability to call upon God to do supernatural acts that cause others to consider God's will for their lives.
PASTOR/ SHEPHERD	Spiritual caring	Ability to care for, feed, guide, and protect the long-term spiritual needs of people and oversee their growth in Christ.
PROPHECY/ PROPHET	Recognition, proclamation, quality control	Ability to boldly recognize errors and sinful behavior and a driving compulsion to confront others, proclaiming God's truth related to the present and future.
SERVING	Meeting practical, physical needs	Ability to identify and use whatever resources necessary to meet the practical needs of others.
TEACHING/ TEACHER	Communicate and illustrate truth	Ability to understand and accurately communicate the truth of God in a clear and relevant manner so that people learn.
TONGUES - INTERPRETATION	Interpreting tongues	Ability to understand and communicate the meaning of an unknown language spoken by someone with the gift of tongues.
TONGUES - SPEAKING	Authoritative Word in certain contexts	Ability to speak a language, known or unknown, without prior knowledge of that language.
WISDOM	Practical application	Ability to discern and counsel others with applicable principles and knowledge from God's Word for complex situations.

SCRIPTURAL REFERENCES

1 CORINTHIANS 12:8-10

8 To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, 10 to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues.

1 CORINTHIANS 12:28-30

28 And God has placed in the church first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, of helping, of guidance, and of different kinds of tongues. 29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? 30 Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret? 31 Now eagerly desire the greater gifts.

ROMANS 12:6-8

6 We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; 7 if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; 8 if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

FMBC MINISTRIES

Adult Music & Arts - Adult choirs, praise teams, and band; provide music and arts for all services & events

Campus Care Team - assists with parking & general campus security; provides assistance to persons new to campus, the elderly, & those with difficult mobility; background check required

Career Awards Program (CAP) - Offers programs, events, and scholarships to support & encourage youth who are continuing their education at a post-secondary college/university, vocational institution, or branch of the armed services

Communication Team - Responsible for all FMBC internal & external communication, including marketing, advertisement, social media, creative content, website

Connection Team - FMBC's "HR Department;" team assures every member has a "job" by connecting individuals to ministries and various opportunities to volunteer and serve

Couples Affirming Marriage (CAM) - Open to married, dating, or engaged couples. It promotes healthy marriages and strengthens those in need by providing workshops, one-on-one counseling, small group sessions, couples' retreats, and more

E.G.G.S. (Emerging Grateful Global Scholars) - Six-week educational enrichment program with classes that include Spanish, spiritual development, math, science, creative writing, music, dance, financial development, arts & crafts, health & wellness, leadership, & field trips

FIYAH (Fearless Inspired Young Adult Hearts) - Young adult ministry (ages 19-39) designed to create a safe and nurturing atmosphere for young adults and their families through peer-appropriate small groups, worship, fellowshiping, and Christian support

Family Ministry - Manages worship, small groups, outreach, events & fellowship for school-aged children through young adults and their families; background check required

Guest Services - Assists with check-in for all FMBC services & events, manages the first-time guest experience, assists with event registration and general needs of guests during events

Health Cabinet - Partnering with our Faith Community Nurse, this ministry provides programs & services to foster holistic health among members & the community

History Committee - Archives & preserves church history/artifacts; curates historical exhibits for FMBC services & programs

Hospitality & Events - The FMBC event planning team; provides food, decor, and other support for church & ministry events

Hosts & Greeters - Responsible for welcoming, greeting & seating guests; this team helps guests navigate the FMBC campus at all services & events

Intercessory Prayer Team - Internal leadership team that regularly & consistently prays for all church endeavors

Men's Ministry - Open to all men aged 18 & over; designed to support men by providing opportunities for spiritual and emotional growth

Media Ministry - Responsible for setup, maintenance, coordination, and use of all equipment associated with the production & duplication of audio or video media used and distributed by FMBC, for amplifying, recording, and sharing God's Word; includes audio, video, lighting, and live-streaming

Ministry on Wheels - provides transportation to most services and other events; members must have a valid NC driver's license, submit to a background check & road test, and be approved by our insurance carriers

Next Step Team - Manages follow-up for first-time guests & any other guest requesting a know more about programs, ministries, & serving opportunities at FMBC

Noah's Ark Nursery - offers a safe, secure, child-friendly environment where parents with children, ages 6 months to 4 years, may feel confident in leaving their children; team members must be at least 16 years old & pass a criminal background check

Operation Breadbasket - Volunteer group assisting the House of Hope's weekly food distribution services; the House of Hope is a non-profit organization providing various *FREE* services to families in crisis, including food, health services, financial & mental health counseling

Photography Team - Team captures photos & video clips of FMBC life & activities for promotional use

Scripture Alive Ministry (SAM) - Drama ministry; responsible for 2 large annual productions (Easter & Christmas) and other small commercials, skits throughout the year

Seniors on the Move - Encourages & manages worship, fellowship, and growth opportunities for senior adults (62 & over)

Sisterhood On Mission - Women's Missionary Circle; manages local & global mission efforts

TotallyU Women's Ministry - Designed to support women by providing opportunities for spiritual and emotional growth through retreats, seminars & conferences, and small group opportunities

Youth Music & Arts - youth praise & dance teams; provide music and dance for youth worship and other FMBC events
